

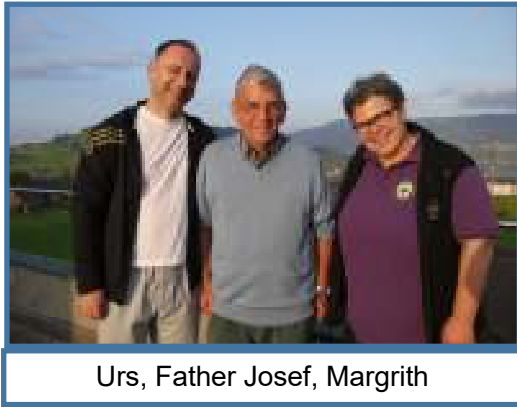

Father Josef Eugster was born in Switzerland in 1940. His ambition was to become a teacher or a doctor, but unfortunately his family was poor and couldn't afford to financially support his training. During certain events in his life, his desire to help people led him to become a priest and in 1970 circumstances guided him to a life in Taiwan.

In 1977, Father Josef suffered from Rheumatoid Arthritis in his knees. He was introduced to and learned the art of foot reflexology. He realized the technique was an effective treatment which had cured his condition and with considerable self study and research, he started to share and treat others suffering from various physical conditions. He realized great and dramatic successes and word spread of his abilities and technique. Radio and TV personalities picked up on these successes and highlighted his technique by documenting them through personal interviews.

Over time, Father Josef started training therapists with he and his technique becoming well known throughout Asia. He is one of few responsible for successfully re-introducing foot reflexology in Asia. A great accomplishment considering that it is traditionally inappropriate and offensive for people to show the bottom of their feet to anyone.

In 2017, during the International Council of Reflexologists Conference in Taiwan, four people were officially appointed as head teachers of the “Father Joseph Technique” , which included Margrith and Urs. They have travelled throughout Europe, Middle East, Asia and Africa teaching this successful art.

This course is open to all Reflexologists. Plan on joining us in learning “how to apply the Father Joseph Technique”.
